Dubai Helicopter Ride

Sheikh Saeed Al Maktoum House

This is a historic building and the former residence of Sheikh Saeed, the former ruler of Dubai and grandfather of current Dubai ruler Sheikh Mohammed bin

Rashid. This 1896 crown jewel is home to many historic moments, artefacts, and other memorabilia significant to the old town of Dubai.

Frame Dubai

Frame Dubai consists of two towers connected by a 100 square meter bridge. At the top, visitors can have a bird's-eye view of old Dubai as they look towards Al Karama, Umm Hurair, Bur Dubai and Deira, and as they turn around, will see the high-rise towers and development projects of new Dubai in contrast.

Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque

This architectural work of art is one the world's largest mosques, with a capacity for an astonishing 40,000 worshippers. It features 82 domes, over 1,000 columns, 24 carat gold gilded chandeliers and the world's largest hand knotted carpet.
